We do not disclose any nonpublic personal information about our customers or former customers to anyone, except as permitted by law.

DISCLOSURE AS PERMITTED BY LAW

We may disclose all of the information we collect, as described above, to service providers and and companies that perform marketing services on our behalf. (I.e. Check printing companies)

CONFIDENTIALITY AND SECURITY

We restrict access to nonpublic personal information about you to those employees who need to know that information to provide products or services to you. We maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards that comply with federal standards to guard your nonpublic personal information.
